

# NIH Data Sharing Policy Comparison

Key differences between the 2003 Data Sharing Policy and the NEW Data Management and Sharing (DMS) Policy, effective for due dates on/after January 25, 2023

Policy Provision	2003 Data Sharing Policy	2023 Data Management and Sharing Policy
<b>Scope</b>	Awards $\geq$ \$500K a year	All awards generating scientific data See <a href="#">Research Subject to the DMS Policy</a>
<b>Data to share</b>	Final research data	Scientific data regardless of whether data underlie a publication See <a href="#">FAQ</a>
<b>Mode of sharing data</b>	To be described in Plan	Encourages use of established repository named in Plan See <a href="#">Sharing Scientific Data</a>
<b>Plan elements</b>	Flexible level of detail	Plans should address 6 key elements See <a href="#">Writing a DMS Plan</a>
<b>Plan location in application</b>	Resource Sharing section of application	New section of application called “Other Plans(s)”
<b>Budget Requests</b>	Combined with other direct costs	Costs requested in the appropriate cost categories (e.g., personnel, equipment, supplies, other expenses), following standard form instructions, with accompanying justification See <a href="#">Budgeting for DMS</a>
